

UK and Ireland Energy Policy



Our policy is to:

- Maintain an Energy Management System which meets the requirements of ISO50001 :2011 through corrective action and continuous improvement
- Where possible reduce energy costs, eliminate waste, and conserve energy resources by adopting energy efficient and cost effective technology in line with best practices available
- Incorporate energy efficiency into the decision-making process during the design and acquisition of facilities, equipment, and transportation with a focus on renewable energy sources
- Promote vehicle energy efficiency through emphasis on efficient fuel use, operation and maintenance of fleet vehicles.
- Improve energy performance through capital investment and improved operations and energy conscious procurements.
- Recognise and promote individual and functional level achievements in conserving energy, advancing energy policy and obtaining monetary savings
- Provide all the information and resources needed to fulfil the requirements of this energy policy.

This policy will be reviewed on an annual basis at the Management Review. The UK and Ireland Executive Committee is responsible for setting this policy, and as such provides the cornerstone for the companies' activities and quality performance.
